

Streamlined billing with CxLink for ArchiveLink nets 40% in annual savings for FortisOntario

Cost savings supports the company purpose of superior financial performance, enabling stronger focus on service delivery and local community engagement.







Overview


The emphasis that FortisOntario places on service delivery and support of the communities it serves is clear across virtually every page of the energy delivery company's website. It is in the energy delivery business, operating in defined areas in Canada's largest and most populous province.

And since it operates as a regulated electric utility, the nature of its business begins with owning and operating infrastructure that safely and reliably distributes electric service to its customers. But FortisOntario's concept of service certainly doesn't end there.

With operations are spread across three distinct operating electric grids, they are connected by 3,500km of power lines that serve a combined 68,000 customers located in Fort Erie, Port Colborne, Cornwall, Gananoque and the Algoma District of Northern Ontario.

As all regulated utilities do, FortisOntario issues monthly invoices to its customers, which end up totaling well more

than 50,000 each month. So, the billing function became a mammoth task they sought to manage in-house, with integration to their new self-service portal for enhanced customer interaction. To get to that goal, the company chose to implement the CxLink for ArchiveLink, a solution developed by Syntax department and certified by both SAP and AWS, for this purpose.

Addressing Challenges Smartly

The FortisOntario IT team, which facilitated the company and its distributions' daily operations through the on-premise SAP IS-U utility industry solution, identified a need to overhaul the legacy invoice issuance process. They envisioned enabling the company to issue invoices internally, thus improving customer interactions, enhancing system reliability, significantly reducing costs, and integrating seamlessly with user-friendly customer tools such as the self-service portal. The ultimate goal was to develop a comprehensive internally managed service where PDF invoices generated by SAP IS-U Billing are stored securely and made accessible to customers.

Crafting Customer-centric Solutions

To enable the transition to in-house administration, FortisOntario needed to rethink its document management strategy. They decided to migrate their SAP Content Server to the AWS cloud for enhanced flexibility, scalability and agility to accommodate large volumes of documents. The integration to Amazon S3 services via the cutting-edge CxLink for ArchiveLink, developed by Syntax, streamlined the process.

Experiencing the Benefits

The solution has resulted in considerable cost savings for FortisOntario, with document storage on AWS costing as little as approximately \$0.50 per month. This shift to an 'inhouse' solution not only led to tremendous control over the billing process but also ensured high data availability.

The introduction of the self-service portal where customers can monitor their electricity usage, view payments and access stored invoices is highly appreciated. The massive reduction in cost is another significant highlight, with the e-billing solution saving around 40% annually compared to the legacy solution and the savings expected to grow as more customers opt for paperless invoicing.

Envisioning the Future

Given the success FortisOntario has had with CxLink for ArchiveLink with both significant cost savings and service improvements, FortisOntario is exploring other capabilities of the CxLink for ArchiveLink, in addition to other Syntax offerings. One possibility is to move the archiving function of their business data to AWS using CxLink for ArchiveLink.

In addition, they are evaluating plans at some point in the near future to migrate their SAP environment to the AWS cloud from where their current environment is hosted.


